Passage One · 外在美与内在美

46 B

What do we learn about American society from the first paragraph?

解析：第一段指出美国社会高度重视外表（places a high value on physical beauty），对应 **B**。A项“浪费收入”过度，C项“明星健身”未提及，D项“期望每个人都最佳”不准确。

47 C

What happens when people strive to look better?

解析：人们可能忽视培养更重要的内在品质（neglect to cultivate the inner qualities that matter more），原文：“... fail to attend to ourselves ... move us toward deeper intimacy.” 选 **C**。

48 D

What does the author say about outer beauty?

解析：外在美可能既带来好处也带来坏处（may do as much harm as good），原文：“Outer beauty can be as much of a curse as a blessing.” 选 **D**。

49 A

What brings about spiritual connection?

解析：内在世界的交汇（meeting of our inner worlds）带来精神联系，即“meeting of minds”（心灵相通）。选 **A**。B项“一见钟情”基于外表，C项“生理吸引”是初步的，D项“频繁互动”非核心。

50 C

What happens when we take the path toward cultivating inner beauty?

解析：最终我们会遇到欣赏真实我们的灵魂伴侣（meet people who value us for who we are），原文：“... find those compatible souls who appreciate us as we are.” 选 **C**。A项“找到通往他人灵魂的路径”不准确，B项“被更多人欣赏”无依据，D项“被劝阻展现真我”相反。

Passage Two · 植物肉

51 **C**

What can we expect of plant-based meats?

解析：市场预测显示消费将大幅增长（a huge boost in their consumption），原文预测2023年达740亿美元，增长957%。选 **C**。A项“分析兴趣”、B项“推广努力”、D项“品种激增”均不准确。

52 **A**

What do we learn about consumers buying Beyond Burger and Impossible Foods products?

解析：超过九成购买者同时也是肉食者（mostly non-vegetarians），原文：“... more than nine out of ten consumers who buy ... also eat meat.” 选 **A**。

53 **B**

What can we conclude about Impossible Foods' products from Joan Solsman's remark?

解析：她的评价表明产品非常像真肉（very much resemble animal meat），因为她感到恶心吃不下，说明仿真度高。选 **B**。A项“更吸引肉食者”不是她的观点，C项“成为招牌菜”未提及，D项“作为真肉销售”错误。

54 **D**

Why can the habit of eating a plant-based diet lead to better health?

解析：因为减少了肉类消费带来的各种健康风险（reduces various health risks posed by meat consumption），如红肉致癌、血压血糖等问题。选 **D**。A项“摆脱

所有癌症联系“过于绝对，B项“提供所有营养”不准确，C项“维持正常血压血糖”只是部分好处。

55 **A**

What does the author recommend we eat at the end of the passage?

解析：作者最后推荐天然食品（naturally produced foods），如豆类（beans），而非加工替代品。原文：“... don't forget about whole grains and vegetables. Beans are an especially excellent protein substitute.” 选 **A**。B项“加工蛋白替代品”被否定，C项“传统红肉”不推荐，D项“新一代替代肉”过度关注。
