要点提示：所学专业 – 职业/ 对自己未来工作的规划 – 兴趣，收益

结构提示：I don't have a clear mind of what kind of jobs I'll have in the future, but I'm sure it's computer science related. Because that's my major and I enjoy learning these stuff. Also, people nowadays almost can't work without computers, so I believe I'll have many job opportunities in this area.

Part 3

1. What are the most popular types of children' s books in your country?

要点提示：漫画（连环画）/ 绘本等 – 书的特点（图片多，容易理解等）

结构提示：I guess it should be comics. These books have more pictures or illustrations than words, which make it easier for children to read, to understand. Additionally, the plot is usually much more appealing. Take my little nephew for example, whenever I visit his home, I would see him reading comics and he reads so fast. I believe he can quickly gain the information from pictures, which means he can easily get entertained from reading comics.

2. What are the benefits of parents reading books to their children?

要点提示：更多的亲子时间，增进情感联系/ 养成良好的阅读习惯

结构提示：The most obvious benefit I can think of is building a strong bond between parents and



their children through reading books together. I mean, when parents read books to their children, they are going through the story or knowledge together. So they may have the same feeling to story, and they may be happy or upset together. This way, children and parents will have more topics to discuss, and thus, they can be good friends.

3. Should parents always let children choose the books they read?

要点提示：不应该 “always” – 心智不够成熟/ 有些书会包含暴力等儿童不宜的内容

结构提示：I don't think so, and the matter is “always”. Children are called children because they are not mature enough, not only their bodies but also their minds. Sometimes they cannot tell right from wrong. So here comes the problem, there can be violence in some books and it will be really dangerous if children imitate these things. So I believe parents should respect what their children choose to read, but also supervise what they read.

4. How popular are electronic books in your country?

要点提示：很流行 – 理由、优势（便捷）

结构提示：Oh, these books are quite popular, because e-books can be read on many different types of devices, like computers, tablets, mobile phones, and Kindles. It's so convenient. And people can also put a variety of books into their one specific device, which makes it so easy to carry. For example, when I take a bus or subway, I usually see people reading books on their phones or



Kindles. And I read e-books too, when I commute.

5. What are the advantages of reading electronic books (compared to printed books)?

要点提示：省钱、便利 – 电子书通常比纸质版便宜，甚至免费/ 节省空间 – 纸质版需要空间存贮

结构提示：Well, obviously, there are many advantages of reading electronic books, and the first one should be money saving. We can find that electronic editions are usually cheaper than printed ones. So for an avid reader, buying e-books and reading them on a device are more affordable. Additionally, reading e-books makes it easier for people to read anywhere anytime. I mean, people can use their mobile phones to read instead of carrying a heavy printed book all the time, which is a bit cumbersome.

6. Will electronic books ever completely replace printed books in the future?

结构提示：Maybe not, because in spite of the great things e-books accomplish — convenience, portability, multimedia — there are still some fundamental qualities they will simply never possess. For example, paper books have physical beauty. E-books are great for people who care only about the contents, but for people who truly love books, printed books are the only medium that will satisfy.

Part 1

1. Which social media websites do you use?

要点提示：微信，微博等 – 特点（朋友分享的趣事，最新消息，新闻等）

结构提示：I mainly use Wechat, and actually it's a social media app. Most of my families and friends use this app too, so we can get connected no matter where we are. And there is also a function in this app called Moments, where I can see their updates like funny news they repost and useful information they share.

2. How much time do you spend on social media sites? [Why/Why not?]

Sometimes I also post my selfies with my cats, because they are so cute and maybe I just want to make others jealous.

4. Is there anything you don't like about social media? [Why?]

要点提示：社交媒体上的“虚假” – 并非生活中的真实样子，只展现“希望别人看到的生活”

结构提示：I have to say yes, although I use it quite often. Sometimes I fake my lifestyle on social media even without being aware of it myself. For example, I don't like doing sports, but when I go jogging or mountain climbing, I'll share a message on social media to tell others that I'm leading a healthy lifestyle.

Part 3

1. Why do some people buy lots of things for their home?

要点提示：生活需要/ 提升品质/ 营造氛围 – 家，享受人生的地方

结构提示：Partly because some basic needs I suppose. For example, people buy a TV for living room, a bed for bedroom, because they need watch TV programs after dinner for relaxation and sleep on a comfortable bed for a good rest. In addition, some things are for decoration purpose, like paintings and flowers. People are willing to make their homes cozy, so after a hectic day, they



can finally enjoy their life at home.

2. Do you think it is very expensive to make a home look nice?

要点提示：与钱无关 – 舒适，干净，整洁才是核心

结构提示：I don't think so. I believe making a home look nice is a matter of its being neat and tidy rather than using expensive stuff. I mean, the room won't look nice when it's in a mess even if you put lots of luxury goods in it. But you'll definitely feel relaxed and delighted if the furniture and decorations in the room are in good order.

3. Why don't some people care about how their home looks?

要点提示：每个人关注的事情不同 – 家只是休息的场所/ 不邀请他人做客

结构提示：I believe different people care about different things in their life, so it's acceptable that there are people who don't care about how their home looks. Maybe it's because a home for them is just a place to sleep, to rest. And they don't even invite friends to their home. So there is no need for them to decorate it or keep it nice and tidy.

4. In what ways is living in a flat/ apartment better than living in a house?

要点提示：公寓住宅通常更靠近市中心，有位置上的优势/ 价格相对亲民



结构提示 :The location I suppose. I mean, if you don't have a car then the location of your property could be crucial. If you are starting a new job or need to be in the city center, then an apartment is likely to suit you better than a house. It's much easier for an apartment complex to afford to be in a desirable city location, whereas houses are much more expensive to build for a single homeowner.

5. Do you think homes will look different in the future?

要点提示 : 不会 – 房子的样子 , 几百上千年没有变化 , 变化的是使用的家具

结构提示 :I don't think so. When thinking about what houses might look like in 50 to 100 years, it's hard to imagine that they'd be totally unrecognizable to us. It's fun to speculate some of the more unusual, futuristic home styles, but most of them aren't going to become the norm. I believe we'll still have kitchens, living rooms, bedrooms and bathrooms. We'll still sit on sofas, eat at tables and sleep on beds.

6. Do you agree that the kinds of homes people prefer change as they get older?

结构提示 : Yes, I agree. While children and teenagers prefer their home or room colorful and lively, like putting lots decorations on the wall, as adults we may prefer a simply or a sophisticated home style. My own preferences, for example, have changed over the years – I would never have



thought about living in a room without toys when I was a kid.

Test 3

Part 1

1. How often do you see your neighbors? [Why/Why not?]

要点提示：很少 – 不认识，偶尔会碰到，寒暄几句/ 跟邻居是好友，经常一起 hang out

结构提示：Not very often, like three or four times a week. We both have pet dogs, and when I walk my dog downstairs, I may meet her walking her dog as well, so we would exchange some words but not many. She is a bit old and around her seventies I think. She lives alone and that's all I know about her.

2. Do you invite your neighbors to your home? [Why/Why not?]

要点提示：不会 – 租房子，基本不会跟邻居 social/ 彼此不熟悉，贸然邀请对方做客，不太合适

结构提示：No. I rent an apartment here in Beijing and I'm so busy with my work. I don't have time to socialize with my neighbors and I don't even know their names. Also, I have no interest in my neighbors. I mean we have nothing in common. So I never invite my neighbors to my home.



3. Do you think you are a good neighbor? [Why/Why not?]

要点提示：是，也不是 – 自律，不会给邻居添麻烦（吵）/ 跟邻居不熟，很少去主动帮助对方

结构提示：Well, I don't know. Maybe not. I mean, I don't even talk to my neighbors, so they may think I'm a bit indifferent towards them, even selfish who only cares about his own things. But I may as well be considered as a good neighbor, because I don't trouble them. For example, I keep my TV volume down at night.

4. Has a neighbor ever helped you? [Why/Why not?]

要点提示：有的 – 小时候在邻居家写作业等/ 让邻居帮忙照看宠物等

结构提示：Yes, but it was a long time ago when I was a primary school student. I lived in my hometown with my parents back then and that day after school I got home only finding that I left my key in the school. Luckily, my neighbor, a grandma, invited me to her home and even treated me with chocolate cookies. I was so grateful to her help.

jobs.

2. Why do you think some people choose to do difficult jobs?

要点提示：兴趣/ 热爱 – 做一份自己喜爱的工作，还是很重要的/ 难度因人而异

结构提示：Maybe it's a matter of interest or life goals. I mean, when people choose a career, they care more about whether this job is going to fulfill their dream or potential, rather than how easy it is to do the job. Also, I feel that people have different definitions of difficult jobs. I mean, for me I think it would be really hard to be a teacher because I'm not a patient guy but others may think it's easy.

3. Do you agree or disagree that all jobs are difficult sometimes?

要点提示：同意 – 就好比家家有本难念的经，工作也是一样，哪有什么“钱多事儿少离家近”的工作

结构提示：Yes, I agree. There are no completely easy jobs and all jobs can be difficult sometimes. For example, people may think being a bus driver is an easy job, because the route of a bus is usually fixed. But we may not know it's really hard to get a bus driver's license. And driving all day long is harmful to the driver's waist. It may even cause some serious illness.

4. How important is it for everyone to have a goal in their personal life?



要点提示：目标很重要 – 达成目标之后给人以成就感

结构提示：I believe it's vital to have a goal in people's personal life, mainly because it makes their life more meaningful. Life without goals will suffer from a lack of motivation. A goal can be being a successful businessman, and it also can be traveling with your family every year. All of these goals make you feel motivated in your everyday life.

5. Is it always necessary to work hard in order to achieve career success?

要点提示：不是 – 努力工作获取事业上的成功固然是好的，但生活不只有“事业”，不要太执着于“事业成功”

结构提示：I don't think so. Career success should not be the only success in people's life. Not everyone can achieve so called career success. So it's alright to work hard but always working hard in order to achieve career success will somewhat make you feel stressed and exhausted. Instead, I believe work-life balance makes a successful life.

6. Do you think that successful people are always happy people?

要点提示：不是 – 成功和快乐是两回事儿/ 成功和快乐的定义都很模糊，每个人对它的理解也不一样

结构提示：I don't think so. Success doesn't mean happiness. Also, people have different definitions on success and happiness. Some people think money, which is usually associated with successful people, can buy happiness but others don't think so. Also, everyone has a skeleton in



the closet. When we assume someone is successful, he may be suffering from difficult things.

要点提示：喜欢 – 小区能提供的便利（商店，公交站，安全性等）

3. What new things would you like to have in your neighborhood? [Why/Why not?]

要点提示：健身房/ 球场/ 停车场 – 自己的喜好/ 提升生活的便利性

结构提示：I' ve always wanted a basketball court built in my neighborhood because I love playing basketball and I have to drive to a university if I want to play basketball after work or on weekends. So if there is a basketball court, I will be on the top of the world.

4. Would you like to live in another neighborhood in your town or city? [Why/Why not?]

要点提示：不会 – 习惯了现在的社区环境

结构提示：No, I wouldn' t. Although my neighborhood is not a perfect place to live in, I' ve got used to it. I know every single aspect of my neighborhood, like where to walk my dog, when to catch the earliest bus to go downtown, and which store to get fresher vegetables. So that' s why I wouldn' t like to live in another neighborhood.

要点提示：电子产品（标准化）/ 生活用品（多样化，性价比）

结构提示：Electronic devices, like smartphones and tablets. Because these things are not easy to fake, and buying them online helps you save money. Think about it, you actually buy the same



thing but with a lower price, and your gadget bought from the internet has a twelve month warranty as well. So people are willing to buy them online.

2. Why has online shopping become so popular in many countries?

要点提示：优势 – 便捷（随时随地购物）/ 价格（通常比实体店便宜）

结构提示：I guess online shopping meets people's various needs, for example, convenience. I mean, where else can you comfortably shop at midnight while in your pajamas? There are no lines to wait in and you can do your shopping in minutes. Online shops give us the opportunity to shop all the time.

3. What are some possible disadvantages of buying things from online shops?

要点提示：缺点 – 无法体验（购买衣物类产品，无法试穿等）/ 售后问题

结构提示：Shipping problems and delays. Even the biggest and best shipping companies and online retailers have their bad days, so there's no way to ensure that you'll get your hands on your purchase in time unless you pick it up from a physical store. Items get lost, detoured, damaged, or delivered to the wrong address more often than you can imagine.

4. Do you agree that the prices of all goods should be lower on internet shopping sites than in shops?



要点提示：不同意 – 大部分确实是，但涉及到运费，有些东西就得另当别论了

结构提示 I don't agree. People believe the prices are lower online because there is no rental. That's true but there are also other fees like shipping fees adding to the cost. So we may find some of the prices online are even higher. For example, your bathroom lamp is broken, and you need a bulb to replace the broken one. But ordering a bulb online won't save you money because of the shipping fee.

5. Will large shopping malls continue to be popular, despite the growth of internet shopping?

要点提示：会的 – 购物中心可以提供体验式购物，而且拥有其他娱乐配套，同时有社交属性

结构提示 :Yes, I believe they will continue to be popular, because shopping malls can provide some features that online shops can never do, for example, socializing. Shopping with friends or family is an important activity people do in their daily life. When shopping with others, they can catch up on each other's news and thus strengthen their bond.

6. Do you think that some businesses (e.g. banks and travel agents) will only operate online in the future?

要点提示：会的 – 类似电子书，基本都是线上售卖的/ 未来会有更多只在线上的商业模式

结构提示：Yes, I think so. Even nowadays there are some businesses only operate online, like



e-books. We can hardly find a physical store that sells e-books. So in the future, I believe there will be more businesses only operate online, because almost everyone use the Internet, even senior citizens, and if there is no need to make the deal in a store, why don' t put all of them online?
